All walkers should carry a contact name and telephone number which could be used should the need arise. This may be stored on a mobile phone under the name "ICE" (In Case of Emergency).

5 key things for walk leaders

• First aid - The person responsible for their safety and happiness on a walk is the individual. It is wise to carry a simple first aid kit or ensure someone else in the group has one.

- We have now purchased walk leaders' packs for our walk leaders to carry, although this does not mean the leader is in any way responsible for individuals. See below for details
- Insurance all walk at their own risk
- In case of emergency, be sure you or one of the group have a charged phone at hand and know how to explain your position to the emergency services.

See and familiarise yourself with what3words https://what3words.com/how-to-use-the-what3words-app

And with grid references https://gridreferencefinder.com/

- make sure you know the route by walking it out in advance; beware of too many busy roads and consider if there are any other hazards
- appoint a back-marker if you have more than ten walkers and together ensure that you don't lose anyone. Make sure you can communicate with the back-marker.
- encourage everyone to carry a card or an ICE Phone with Next of Kin

Mid Herts Footpaths Society Walk Leaders Pack

The pack includes the following:

- A first Aid Kit for use in case of injury
- A survival bag to be used to keep warm anybody who is injured or in shock
- Two high visibility jackets to be worn by the walk leader and back marker on any sections of the walk that are on roads
- A whistle to be carried by the back marker in case there is a need to contact the walk leader and there is no mobile phone coverage.
- A note to say In the event of this pack being found please contact Christine Goodwin (0744 909 7313) or one of the walk coordinators.

The leader of each walk should arrange to collect the pack from the appropriate walk coordinator and return it after the walk.

The walk leader and the back marker should exchange mobile phone numbers at the start of the walk.
